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
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
















What is: The Story of (making) Things?

- Capture discussions during brainstorming or ideation using technology using various sensors (audio, video and haptic)
- Develop an integrated SMART system (Tangible bits, AI, Augmented Reality) to process all the information (filter noise/"draw" mind-maps, connect and classify information)
- Augment information when the object is ready for presentation to allow for interaction between man and object.
 - Replay and/or project information (the story)
 - Repeat to record interactions and collect new information (build on knowledge)

Where is the value? Why do we need this?

Interact with physical objects (natural and man-made) in new ways

A grandparent could pass on the story of making a clock or a ship to generations in the far future; using technology in a new manner


Live in the moment when you are creating something; by yourself OR with other people and still preserve ideas/information!


A different approach to appreciate the value of things we have or see in our lives

Save ideas that a generation thousand years from now could still **carry forward**, through the objects themselves, to supplement other resources such as books


